Home Health Services

Our dedicated team includes nurses, physical, occupational, and speech therapists, medical social workers, aides, dieticians, and wound care specialists.

- **Nursing** – Patient instruction, clinical evaluations and skilled care.
- **Physical Therapy** – Therapeutic exercises, gait training, body mechanics and safety evaluation.
- **Occupational Therapy** – Bathroom and adaptive equipment evaluation, activities of daily living training.
- **Speech Therapy** – Language skills assessment, training in cognitive and swallowing disorders.
- **Medical Social Work** – Counseling, community resources, short and long term planning, nursing, home or board & care home placement.
- **Home Health Aides** – Provide and assist with bathing and dressing activities.

Hospice Care

Asian Network is a licensed and Medicare-certified program that meets all professional standards, including State and Federal regulations. The focus of care is on symptom management, comfort, and support related to end-of-life issues.

Our hospice program meets the needs of the terminally ill who wish to seek comfort care, quality of life, and do not wish further aggressive treatment.

Asian Network Hospice offers comprehensive services to the terminally ill and their families. Hospice services include registered nurses, physicians, counselors, social workers, home health aides, volunteers, spiritual counselors, and bereavement follow-up.

In addition, all durable medical equipment and medications related to the terminal illness are covered under the hospice benefit.

- **Registered Nurses** – Provide assistance with pain and symptoms management. Coordinate medical equipment and supplies. A hospice nurse on-call 24 hours.
- **Medical Social Workers** – Provide patients and families with psychosocial support. Assistance with Advanced Directives and other issues related to the terminal illness.
- **Home Health Aides/Homemakers** – Provide and assist with bathing and dressing activities
- **Spiritual Counselor** – Provide spiritual support for patients and their families.
- **Volunteers** – Provide companionship and support in a variety of ways, including running errands, providing respite to caregivers.
